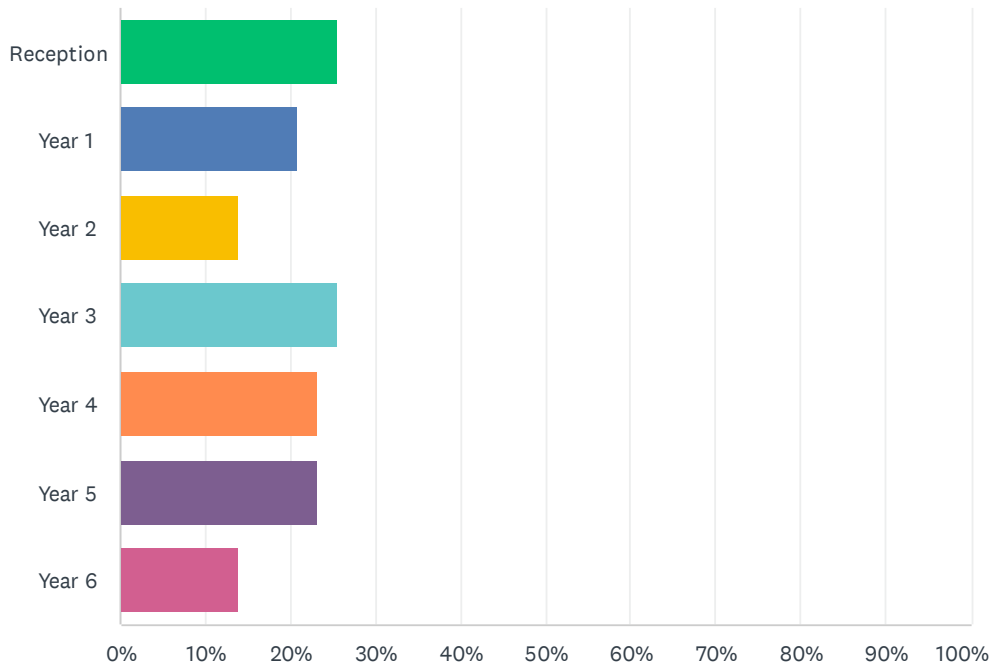


Q1 Which Year group is/are your child/ren in currently? (you may tick more than one box)

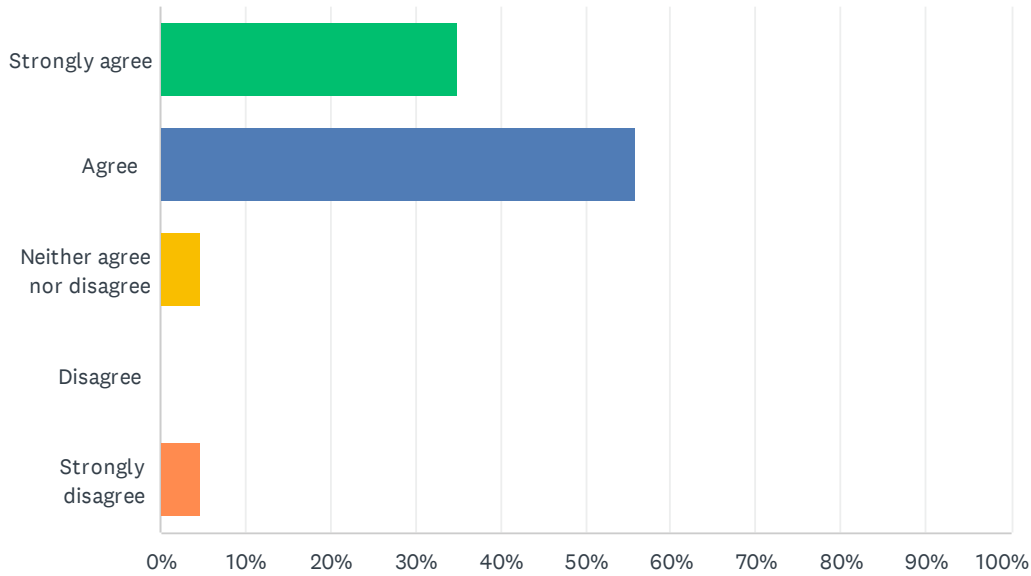

Q2 I think Personal, Social and Health Education, which includes Relationships, Sex and Health Education (RSHE) is an important part of my child's education.

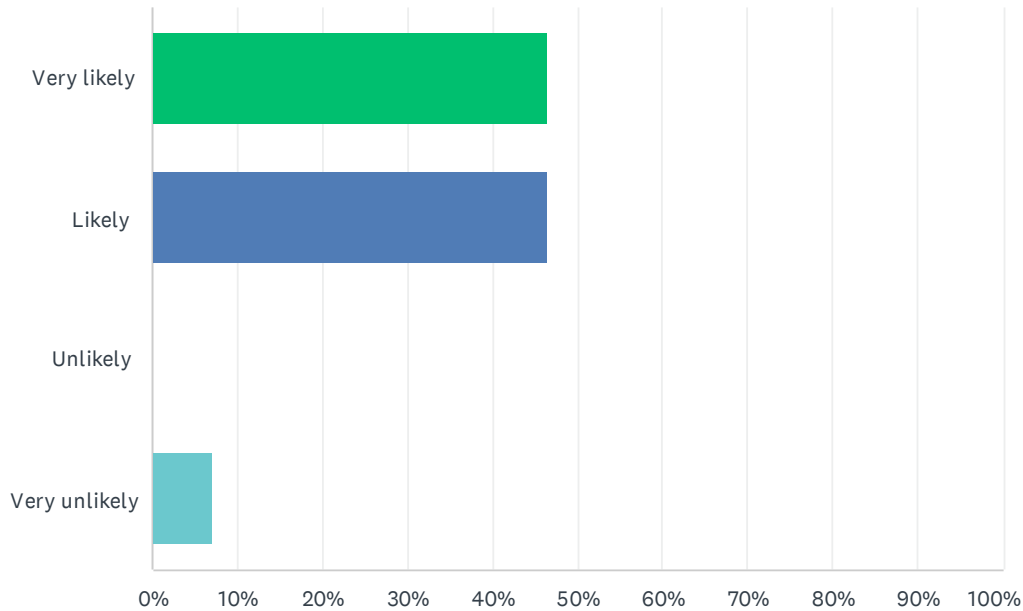

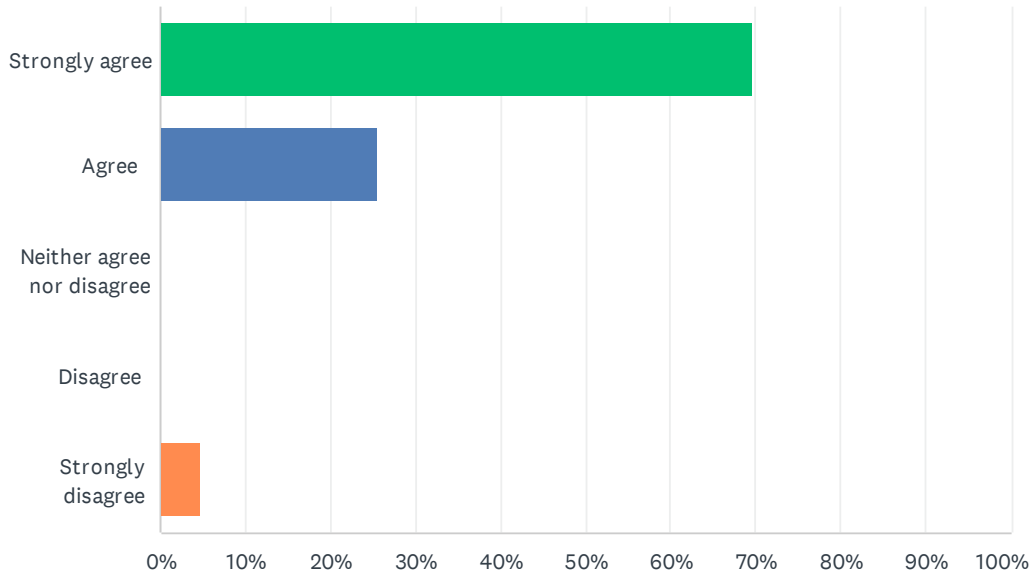

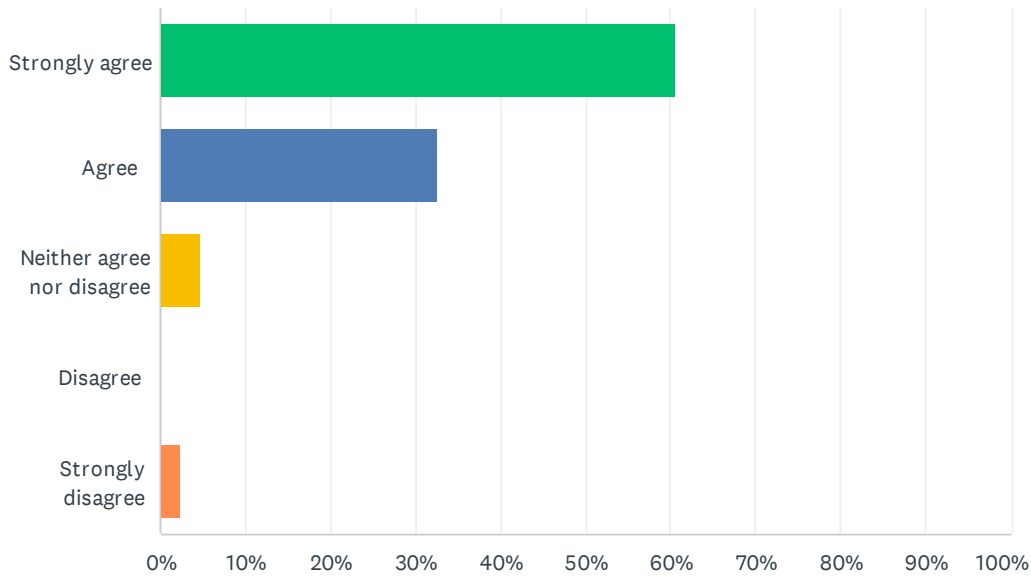

Q5 I feel comfortable talking to my child about puberty, growing up, relationships and how to keep safe.

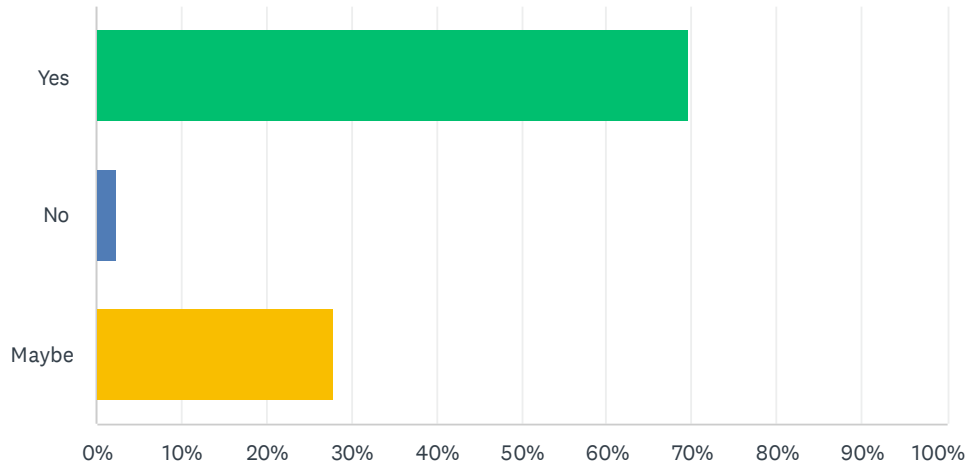

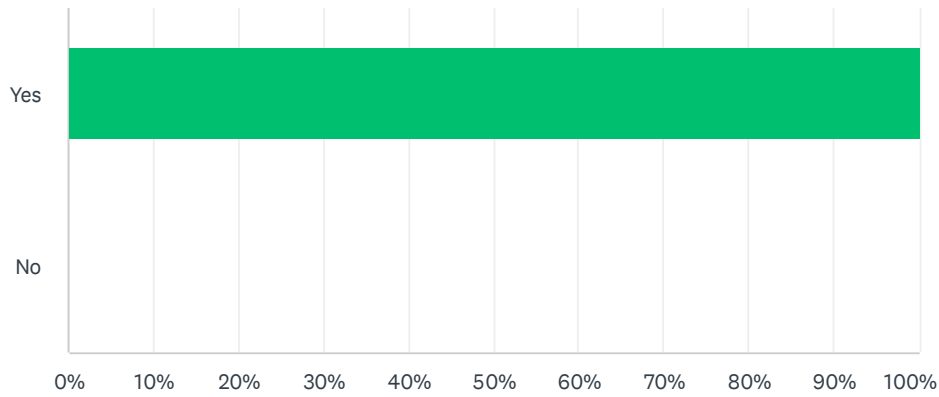

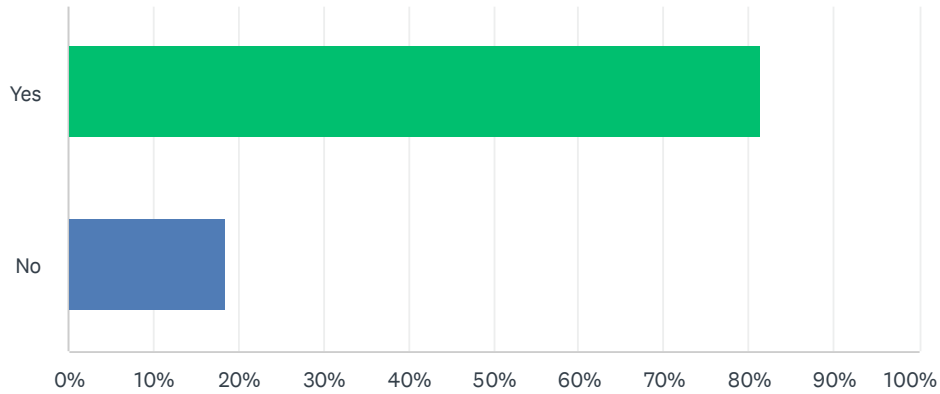

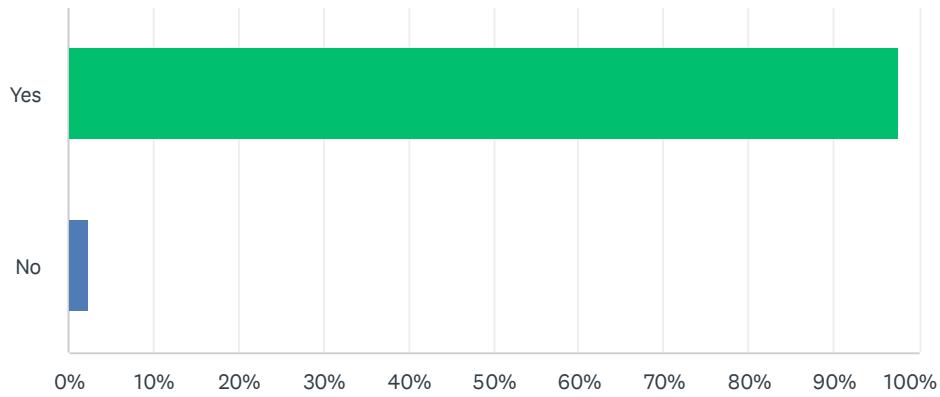

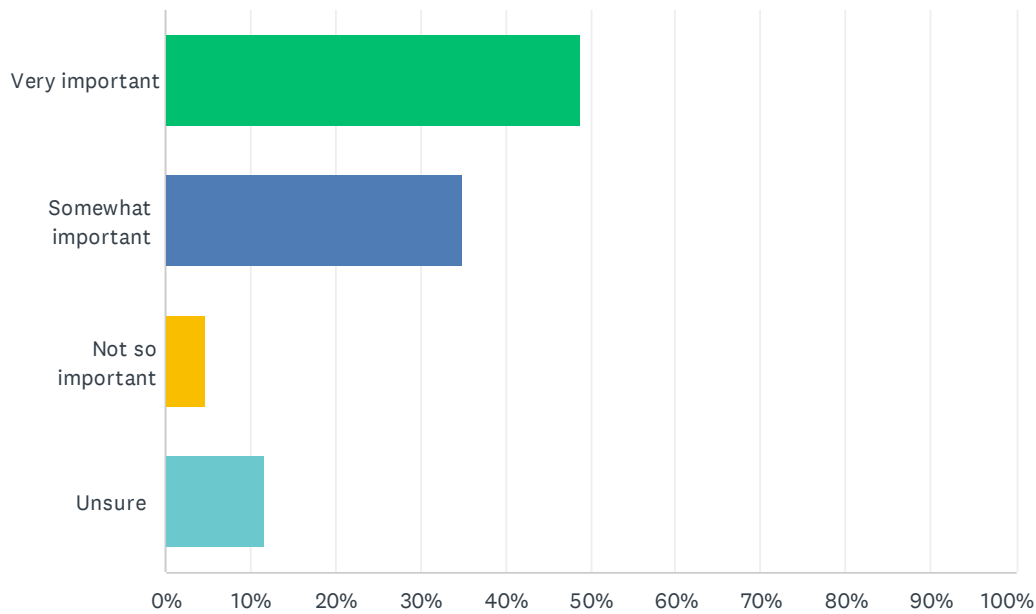
