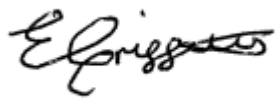
I also want to take this opportunity to thank the staff for their tremendous efforts. Our school has a unique context of not only being a very rural setting but it has the added complexity of being split over two
