2. Objectives of the School Travel Plan

- Encourage safe, healthy, and sustainable travel for all students.
 - Reduce traffic congestion around the school.
 - Promote walking, cycling, and public transport use.
 - Manage the lack of parking facilities at Winfrith.
 - Ensure all travel for school activities (e.g., trips, events) is well-managed and risk-assessed.

3. Current Travel Situation

- **Number of Pupils:** 116
 - **Modes of Transport (currently used):**
 - Walk: 16.3%
 - Cycle: 4.2%
 - Bus: 17.5%
 - Car: 58.6%
 - Other: 3.4%
 - **Issues Identified:**
 - Traffic congestion during drop-off/pick-up times
 - Limited parking and turning space
 - Inadequate pedestrian crossings
 - Lack of walking pavements

4. Travel Initiatives & Solutions

Issue	Initiative	Responsible Party	Timeline
Congestion at gates	Staggered start times, staff to open classroom doors promptly to facilitate to a quick drop off and pick up	SLT / Local Council	Ongoing
Unsafe cycling	Cycle training (e.g., Bikeability)	Teachers / Volunteers	Term 1
Parking problems	"Park and Walk" zones nearby	SLT	Term 1
Lack of awareness	Travel safety workshops	Teachers / Guests	Each term

5. Educational Trips Plan (Example)

- **Frequency:** At least one trip per class per academic year
 - **Types of Trips:**
 - Nature/Science Centres
 - Museums & Heritage Sites
 - Local Libraries & Community Services
 - Educational Farms
 - **Transportation:**
 - School minibus, local coach company
 - Walking where feasible
 - **Permissions & Risk Assessments:**
 - Parental consent collected in advance
 - Staff conduct pre-trip safety checks and site visits
 - Thorough risk assessment produced by EVC
 - Ratios: 1 adult per 5–10 students depending on age

6. Promotion and Communication

- Newsletters and parent briefings
 - Pupil travel councils or “Junior Road Safety Officers”
 - Posters and competitions promoting active travel
 - Updates on school website and noticeboards

7. Monitoring and Review

- **Annual Travel Survey:** Conducted every autumn
 - **Update Travel Plan:** Every academic year
 - **Feedback Mechanisms:** Student council, parent surveys, staff meetings
