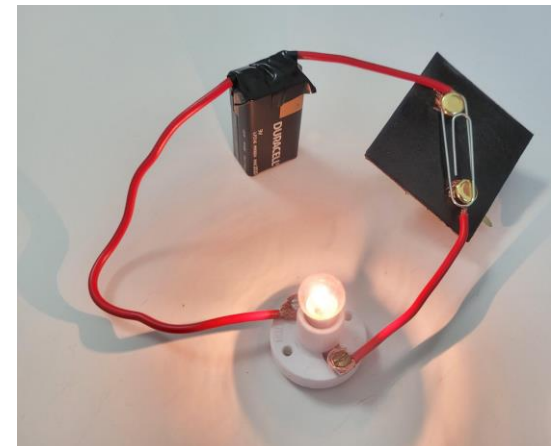
- ☑ To identify the following things in a circuit: cell, wire, bulb, switch, buzzer, lamp.
- ☑ To know how to construct a simple circuit using components.
- ☑ To know that there must be a complete loop for electricity to flow.
- ☑ To know that exposure to high levels of electrical current can be dangerous.
- ☑ To know that electrical current flows well through some materials, called electrical conductors, (most metals) and poorly through other materials, called electrical insulators (wood, plastic).

Word	Definition
Circuit	a closed loop or path through which electric current flows.
Charge	Electric charge can be positive or negative. Like charges repel each other and unlike charges attract each other.
Cell	A single battery which stores electricity.
Wire	A conductor that allow electricity to pass through it.
switch	An electrical component that can close or break a circuit.

I understand...

- ☑ That sculpture is when the artist's thoughts are represented by a (3d) model.
- ☑ -That when joining pieces of clay together, the surfaces between the join should be made rougher (e.g. scratched). This makes the join more likely to hold.
- ☑ -That clay can be moulded to create different shapes e.g. pinch and coil methods.
- ☑ -That specific tools can be used to add marks (as decoration and to create texture).
- ☑ -That art has always been used to express ideas and beliefs.
