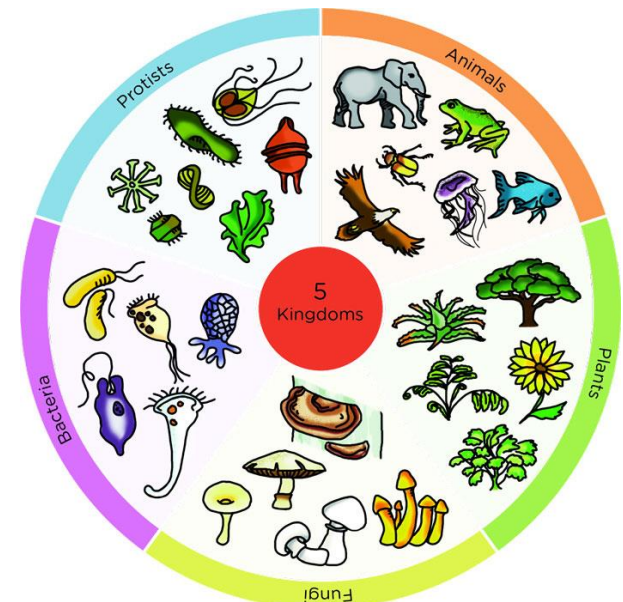

Hinduism - Dharma

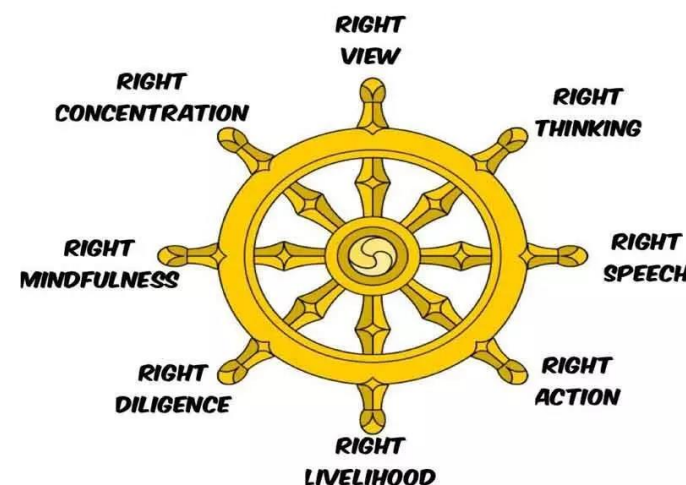
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Key Learning

Rama and Sita	The story of Rama and Sita is a powerful symbol of dharma (righteousness), devotion, and the triumph of good over evil.





Design Technology Lighthouse Structures
