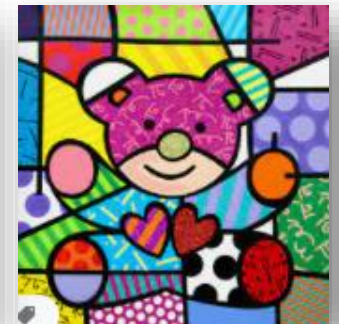

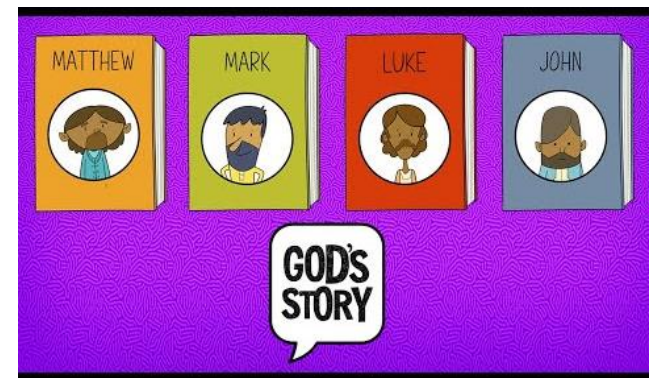

Word	Definition
Gospel	Good news. For Christians, this refers to the Bible stories which share the good news of Jesus' birth and resurrection.
Disciple	Someone who follows a leader or teacher.
Faith	Complete trust or confidence in something or someone even if you haven't seen it/them with your own eyes.

Word	Definition
deciduous	plants that shed their leaves; the leaves fall off
evergreen	plants that never lose their leaves
roots	part of a plant that is usually underground
trunk	the large, strong part of a tree
stem	the part of a plant that holds it upright
