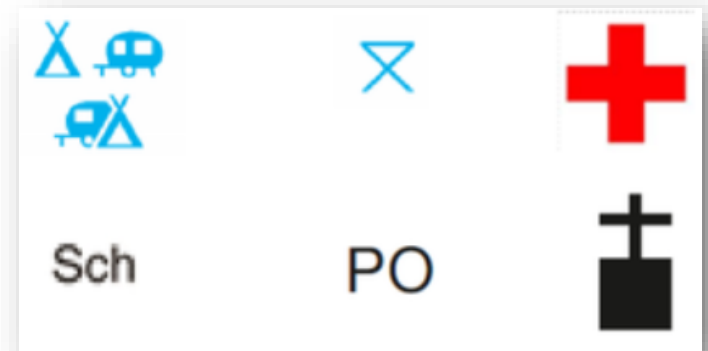
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Key Learning

How to collage (technique)

- 1 – Tearing – Ripping materials such as paper using force.
- 2 – Cutting – Using scissors to get neat edges.
- 3 – Overlapping – Cover something partly by joining over the top.
- 4 – Sticking – Attaching the material with glue or tape.

Collage	A style of art made by sticking materials onto a backing such as paper.
