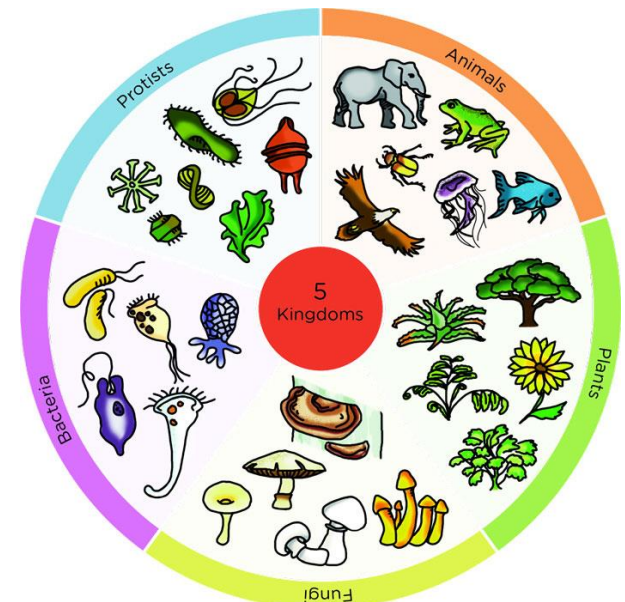

Word	Definition
Predator	An animal that hunts and eats another animal to eat them for food and energy.
Prey	An animal that is hunted by another for food.
Producer	The name given to a living thing that produces its own food, rather than consuming another living thing.
Extinction	The dying out or disappearance of a species from earth.
species	A group of organisms that have common characteristics and enable us to classify living things.

Anglo Saxons and Scots

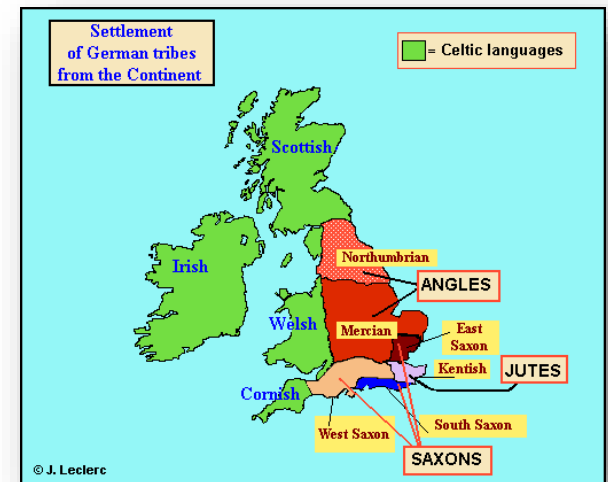
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Key Learning
