

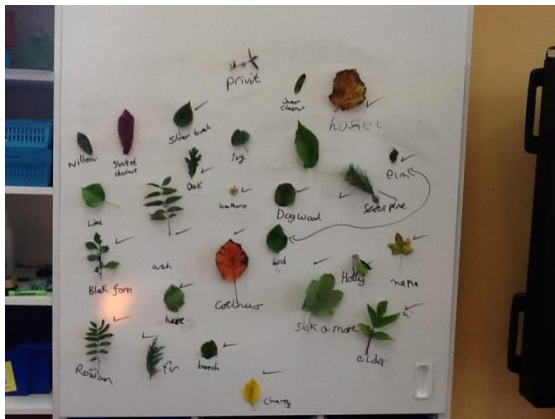

The day began with a walk where the children collected as many different leaves from the trees as they could find. The children learnt the names of many of the trees growing close to the school and how to identify them from their leaves. They also learnt the difference between leaves and leaflets; information that would prove to be vital during our afternoon classification activity.



At the end of the day the children organised a scientific experiment to find out

which leaves earthworms like the best and the class will be recording their results and forming conclusions over the next few weeks!
