## **Snapshot: Blacknoll**

Blacknoll Class had a fantastic trip to Tadnoll Heath on Tuesday 12th May, where we spent the morning learning all about the amazing wildlife and habitats found on the heathland. When we arrived, we were welcomed by Amy from the Dorset Heaths Partnership – and even three curious wild horses who seemed eager to join our adventure!

Amy explained that heathlands are disappearing faster than rainforests, helping us understand why these special places are so important to protect. Throughout the morning, we took part in lots of exciting activities including a scavenger hunt, a bird hunting worms team game, and a “sounds of the heath” challenge. We also explored how lizards use camouflage to stay safe and created our own “smells of the heath” potions using natural materials.

After a tasty snack of biscuits and raisins, we went on a minibeast hunt using sweep nets and discovered many fascinating creatures living in the heathland habitat.

We finished our visit by learning more about the creatures of the heath before saying a big thank you and goodbye to Michelle, Amy and Tink for such a fun and educational experience.
