Dear Families,

It has been another busy and productive week across the school. Year 6 have been thoroughly enjoying their swimming sessions at Purbeck School, building confidence and developing important water safety skills. In Key Stage 1, our Year 1 pupils have approached their phonics screening checks with great focus and determination - we are very proud of their efforts. Meanwhile, our Year 4 children have successfully completed their multiplication test checks, demonstrating the progress they have made with their times tables this year. We have also been delighted to start transition meetings ahead of our new Reception cohort joining us in September.

As we begin to look ahead to September, this is an important time of change for all of our pupils. Last week, I wrote to you to outline our class organisation for September 2026, and over the coming weeks we would like to work with you to support children as they begin to prepare for moving into their next year group.

This period can feel both exciting and a little uncertain for children, as they continue to enjoy their current class while also starting to think about what comes next. In school, we will be creating opportunities for pupils to meet new adults, become familiar with new routines, and build confidence about the changes ahead.

Parents and carers play a vital role in supporting this process. You can help your child by:

- Speaking positively about the move to their next class or year group
- Reassuring them that feeling a little nervous is completely normal
- Encouraging independence and confidence in their daily routines
- Talking about the exciting opportunities and new learning ahead
- Listening to any worries and helping to put them into perspective
